Reading aloud to children on a daily basis has been shown to improve both their reading motivation, or their interest and willingness to read, as well as their reading performance, or how well they read. If every child at ______ was read aloud to each day both at school and at home, they would be getting a double dose of reading that would do wonders for their motivation and performance. Reading and being read to at home are especially important during the summer and winter breaks, when reading often takes a big dip that can set children behind when they return to school.

We value your input and expertise in advancing literacy, and to that end want the resources from the staff workshop to be available for you to view as you wish whether you are a parent or relative of a child at ______, a community volunteer, or just a general advocate of literacy.
